

Schedule

7:15am - Opening Time

We want to start the day off right, we provide a healthy breakfast and some light activities to get your child prepared for the day ahead.

6pm - Closing Time

During our after school club, your children will have a number of different activities to choose from. They can play sport, get creative, take part in role-play, chill out in the reading area, complete any homework they may have and much more.

At 4.30 pm your child will be given a light snack to keep them going until tea time.

Schedule

9am - Opening Time

Our holiday club day begins at 9am and we allow the children some quiet game time for 15 minutes until everyone has arrived, this usually involves a mini arts & craft activity, board games, or imaginative play. Scheduled activities for the day will then begin at 9.15am (see list of activities provided).

5pm - Closing Time

Our holiday club day finishes at 5pm, although you are more than welcome to collect your child sooner if you wish.

We usually open the gates to the premises at around 4.30pm, however, should you wish to collect your child sooner there will be a doorbell you can ring to obtain access.
